I am writing to you to announce that we are opening a class for our school age children, (6 to 10 year olds). We call it Fall Camp. We would like to help our valued parents in any way that we can.

As you know, our preschool has opened after several months that we were closed. I am very thankful to God for our children not experiencing any health related problems. Our close attention to keeping our environment sanitized and clean is paying off.

Our school hours for preschool is full-day 7 AM to 5:30 PM, half-day 7 AM to 12:30 PM and for school age Fall Camp hours full-day 8 AM to 5 PM, half-day 8 AM to 12:30 PM.

You can enroll for Fall Camp starting 11/1/2020. The actual Fall Camp for school aged children will start as soon as we have eight students enrolled. Assisting students with their online public school classes will be the main focus. Other educational enrichment activities, per each student's needs, will be provided during the day as well. Complete lunch and mid morning and mid afternoon snack are provided as usual. Tuition information is available on RHS website.

- Children are fully expected to wear face coverings;

- Daily health screenings and temperature checks will occur at least twice daily.
- Physical distancing will be in place within the classroom to the extent possible following state / local guidelines.
- Parents and visitors are not allowed to enter the building on a regular basis.
